

IQAC Plan of Action 2019 – 20

- To conduct graduation day of the college in the first week of June.
- To conduct a one day workshop for all the faculty members on ‘Teaching-learning using LMS and virtual classroom’ in the month of June just before reopening the college.
- To conduct week long Bridge Course to all new entrants and stream students into slow, moderate and advanced learners in the 3rd week of June.
- To conduct Orientation Programme for fresh faculty of the college in the month of June.
- To organise Induction Programme and campus de tour for new learners on the reopening day.
- To conduct fire safety drill and waste management workshop in the month of July.
- To go for IV cycle of reaccreditation and prepare for NAAC peer team visit in the month of July.
- To go ahead and pursue the procedure involved for the sanction of Autonomy to PG and research lab in Chemistry by AU.
- To take up renovation of chemistry, biochemistry and media labs in the academic year.
- To encourage faculty members to use Virtual Classrooms and smart boards for teaching learning.
- To encourage all the organs of the institution to develop and pursue quality benchmarks in important areas of their functioning.
- To raise pass percentage of UG students from 35 to 40 and compulsory minimum attendance from 60% to 66%.
- To award zero marks out of five for attendance less than 80%.
- To attach 5% weightage to attendance in every semester for every course.
- To have MSE I for 15 marks, MSE II for 15 marks, 5 marks for Accessory assessment and 5 marks for attendance as part of CA.
- To conduct one of the MSE and/or Accessory exam(s) online for all courses in odd and even semesters-based on question bank.
- To support slow learners through structured remedial teaching.
- To develop clear guidelines for Projects and Internship Reports along with Schemes of Valuation.
- To involve more number of students in Internship/On the Job Training.
- To organise two week long training programme in English speaking skills for administrative staff in November.
- To replace SAP Course with other ERP Courses and introduce two month certificate courses in Android Application Development and Yoga.
- To conduct personality development and value based soft skills training classes to II year UG students through an MOU with TalentEase.
- To conduct Spoken English classes to vernacular medium students through English Access Programme of US Consulate.
- To encourage all faculty members to register for LMS.
- To subscribe for MANA TV connection as an LMS resource and make it available to students in specified time slots.
- To strengthen JKC and make it functional by clubbing NCS, CAA & APSSDC activities with it.
- To register for NIRF-2020 rankings.
- To conduct International and national level Conferences & Workshops in languages, humanities and sciences in the academic year.
- To organise peer teaching classes in both semesters and support slow learners through a structured Remedial Coaching Programme.
- To organise training session for newly recruited teachers on conducting mentoring sessions and transacting Personal Transformation Programme in the month of July.
- To strengthen Academic Mentoring and conduct it along with general mentoring in a structured manner.

- To encourage faculty members and students to register for MOOCS and give scope for extra credits to students through them.
- To encourage faculty members to apply for State Best Teacher awards and more major and minor research projects.
- To involve external expertise to conduct ERP & MS Office courses and Coaching for Competitive exams.
- To seek student feedback on 'expectations from the institution', 'courses offered' in all semesters, 'teachers' and 'institutional performance' online and also take necessary action.
- To seek online feedback from all categories of stakeholders on the functioning of the institution and take necessary steps to make the institution stakeholder friendly.
- To make alumni registration online.
- To screen publications by the faculty members of the college for plagiarism by using the software.
- To encourage faculty members of the college to undertake small research projects with the seed money provided by the college.
- To encourage faculty members to publish research articles in reputed journals and departments to publish Journals, Magazines, Newsletters etc.
- To improvise connectivity in the campus and hostel by making the campus Wi Fi enabled through an MOU with Reliance and Fibre net.
- To update and redesign College website.
- To arrange for more and more talks and lectures by eminent people in Faculty Forum and to encourage faculty to give presentations to inculcate research culture in faculty .
