### **Examination Cell Report 2022-2023**

The College established an Examination Cell to take charge of the examination system in the college.

The detailed syllabi, course outcomes, and program outcomes are made available on the college website and in the college library. Orientation is given to the newly admitted batch of students and their parents regarding the system, process, methods, and techniques of assessment and evaluation. The learning outcomes of all courses are also communicated to the students during the orientation program. Institution notifies the faculty and students about courses, syllabus updates evaluation process, examination rules, regulations, etc. through the college handbook. The examination schedule for the academic year is prepared and displayed on the website and notice board.

APSCHE sent Guidelines of Curricular Framework with revised Choice Based Credit System to all the affiliating universities/autonomous colleges with effect from the 2020-2021 academic year. In this context advised the respective Boards of Studies and Academic Councils of all the affiliating universities/autonomous colleges to modify and update the syllabus prepared by the subject committees of APSCHE to a limited extent, without disturbing the Framework recommended.

The syllabus was updated through the Board of Studies and Academic Council and the new courses were introduced to meet the stakeholder demands for 2022-2023.

#### **Examination Cell Report:**

Evaluation of all courses (Papers), theory / practical, and project/dissertation shall be done in two parts, namely by formative assessment (40%) and summative assessment (60%). The End Semester Examination (E.S.E.) shall be conducted for theory / practical papers (courses) as per the requirement of the program. Evaluation of project/dissertation and *viva voce* examination also shall be conducted if the same is included in the syllabi. The aggregate minimum for a pass in each course is 40%

with a separate minimum of 40% for E.S.E. The Examination Cell shall issue mark lists with requisite security features. Andhra University will issue the final degree certificate.

Mid-semester examinations were conducted for V, III & I semesters in the month of September/October/November, 2022 and for VI, IV & I semesters in the month of March/April, 2023. End semester examinations conducted for V, III & I semesters in the month of November 22/December 22/February/March, 2023 and for II, IV & VI semesters in the month of April/May 2023. Around 460 question papers prepared with the help of paper setters from colleges of different states for end semester examinations and the number of papers valued were nearly 170000 with the help of more than 450 examiners from different colleges. Outgoing batch results declared within 15 days. We received 20 applications for revaluation of End semester papers. Out of which marks changed for 5. All the departments prepared question banks for MCQs to conduct online end semester/mid semester/accessory assessment tests.

### **Results:**

The results of 20 AH Batch V Semester examination conducted in the month of December 2022 were presented to the Examination Committee. The Members reviewed the performance of students in Various Subjects/Groups. The committee expressed satisfaction over the results of AH batch students.

The overall pass percentage of V semester is Excellent. Especially CBZ, BBA & Home Science groups recorded 100% 97.5% & 95.65% pass percentage.

Committee Showed concern regarding MEC groups (77.78%) it was advised to take remedial classes or special classes for MEC Students before special supplementary and instant examinations.

The III Semester Results of 21 AI Batch were presented to the Examination Committee. The Members reviewed the performance of students in Various Subjects/Groups.

The overall pass percentage of III semester was good except MEC MPC, BCOM with 29.63%, 53.57%, 55.56% poor performance of MPC&MEC students in Mathematics, Computer science & chemistry theory & practical paper, BCOM students in computer science theory & Practical paper was identified committee advised to take remedial classes or extra coaching for Mathematics, computer science & Analytical skills to improve the performance of students.

The results of 22 AJ Batch I Semester examinations conducted in the month of March 2023. Were presented to the Examination Committee. The Members reviewed the performance of students in Various Subjects/Groups.

The overall pass percentage of I semester was good Except CBZ (19.05%) and MPC (35.20%). It was identified that Botany had the least percentage with 17% only. The committee suggested to compare the MID and END answer sheets as most of them got good marks in mid exams. Also suggested to change the method of teaching. Advised to take special classes for botany paper.

Committee Also discussed about the less pass percentage of physics practical (61.9%), with through discussion it was suggested that students should do physics experiments individually or 2 in a group instead of 3 in a group at a time.

The results of 22 AJ II Semester 21 AI Batch IV Semester 20 AH V SEM, VI Semester examination conducted in the month of April & May 2023. 22AJ I Semester B.Sc. Agriculture & Rural development results were also presented to the examination committee which were conducted in the month of March ,2023.

The members reviewed the performance of students in various subjects/groups. The overall pass percentage was good for 21 AI Batch IV semesters except MEC, CBZ, & MPC groups with 48% 50% & 58% pass.

The overall pass percentage of II Semester was Good especially MSTC Sc, EEP, EPJ, & MEC Groups with 95%, 94%, 93.7% & 92.3%.

The committee advised to take remedial classes & counseling to improve the performance of students in certain subjects like Botany, Chemistry & Mathematics.

The overall Pass percentage of VI Semester Internship results and I Semester Agriculture results were excellent with 100% pass percentage.

### **Resolutions adopted during Examination Committee meetings in this 2022-2023 academic year:**

Committee decided to adopt new software in examination cell. Demonstration was given by the Bees Software solutions Pvt. Ltd. regarding full Automation of examination on 4-03-2023. They have demonstrated pre-examination, Post examination and Result publication software.

Various doubts were raised regarding the COS POS Mapping, Internal marks; excel sheet preparation, OD student data, supplementary results preparation, instant exams etc. Software People are ready to customize the software according to the needs of the college and clarify the doubts raised by the members present. The session was very useful and informative.

The committee suggested the construction of a reading hall above the library to create a reading atmosphere for students.

The committee also discussed the usage of N-List in library which provide access to e-resources to students.

It was advised to discuss about distribution of marks of apparel design paper in board of studies (Home science)

The committee after discussion decided to give results to students along with their parents at specified time from 1-4 pm within 1 week.

The committee also took notice of the examiners who overvalued or undervalued the answer scripts. The committee Suggested to change those examiners for the next examinations.
