The Minutes of the previous academic council meeting was approved and ratified APSCHE directed the autonomous colleges to modify the syllabus prepared by the subject committees of APSCHE, to a limited extent without disturbing the framework recommended by them.

As per the guidelines of APSCHE, the changes and modifications proposed in syllabi by the chair persons of BOS of various departments have been discussed and ratified after getting clarifications from the respective chair persons of various boards.

- 2. Controller of examinations has presented the details about the reforms and guidelines followed in the college during COVID-19 pandemic and also presented the performance in academics of 2018-19 admitted batch to the council. Council satisfied with the performance of students in various subjects and ratified the results.
- 3. Chair person reported to the council that four NSQF/UGC skill based certificate and two diploma programmes are introduced in 2020-21 academic year but could not start as we did not get any course structure from UGC and also due to Covid-19 situation

Chair person also presented a proposal for discussion about the feasibility to start BSc in Agriculture and Rural Development.

Suggestions from academic council members.

- Members suggested Computer Science department to introduce MOOC courses in addition to the regular curriculum.
- Members also suggested to start student centric courses.
- 3. Members suggested commerce & Management department to record industrial visits and internship programmes in database system & also advised to allow students for internships during working days.
- 4. Members suggested Economics department to conduct a survey on Covid-19 impact on Indian Economy.

Members appreciated the chairperson and the faculty for their efforts and hard work during pandemic situation . Meeting came to an end with the formal vote of thanks proposed by the chair person.

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
