STRATEGIES FOR SUPPORTING SLOW AND ADVANCED LEARNERS

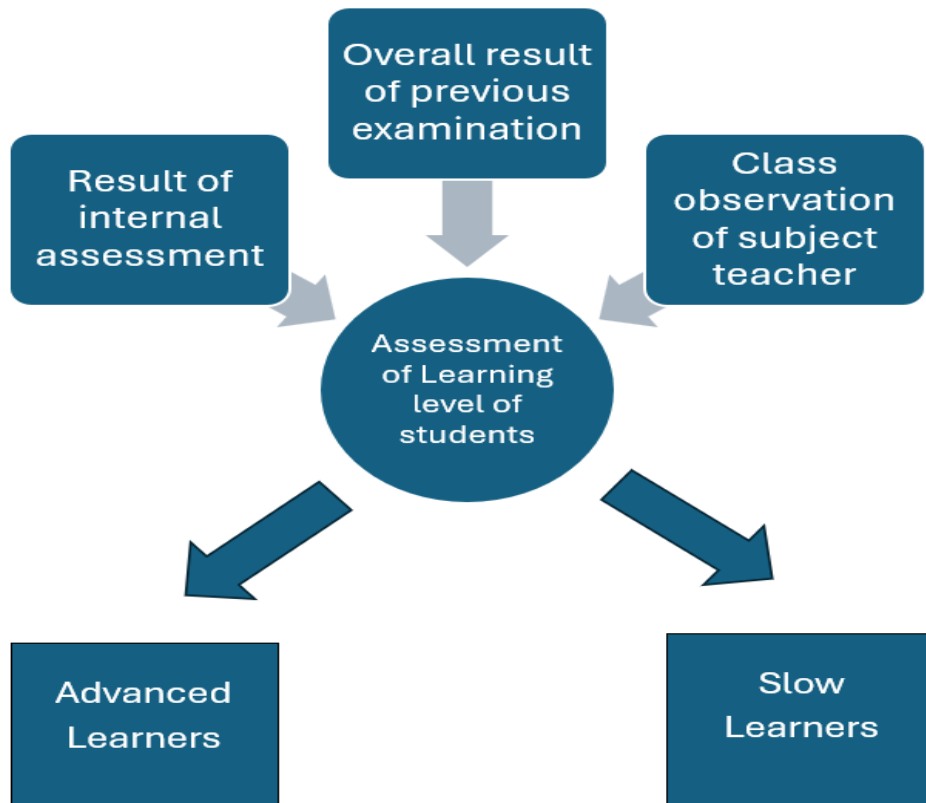
St. Joseph's College for Women (Autonomous), Visakhapatnam recognizes that education is a transformative journey to empower students with essential knowledge and skills to face the challenges of the world. Based on the learner's diversity college designs and execute specialized programs to meet the diverse learning abilities and requirements of each student effectively. This personalized approach ensures that every student receives the support necessary to excel in their educational journey.

This approach involves Assessment of Learning levels of students, Categorization of students based on their learning abilities, Development of differentiated instruction strategies for each category of students and measurement of outcome to follow-up.

Assessment of Learning levels of students: Every year faculty must interact with a diverse range of learners in the classroom, from highly talented and fast learners to those who struggle and progress slowly. In SJCWA students are categorized into two groups as advanced learners, the students who understand a taught topic relatively faster than the other students and slow learners, the students who finds it difficult to understand the topic than the other students.

The purpose of this categorization is to build confidence in slow learners and to nurture advanced learners as excellent achievers. SJCWA encourages faculty to modify their teaching methods to meet the needs of both groups effectively. This ensures that slow learners receive the necessary support and attention, while advanced students remain engaged and encouraged.

The process of identification of slow and advanced learners would be conducted after declaration of preceding exam result by the concerned subject teacher for all programmes considering the inputs from the overall result of previous examination, result of internal assessment, and class observation (learning pace of the students) of subject teacher etc.



Development of differentiated instruction strategies:

Slow learners are those who find it difficult to adjust with the teaching learning process. Their motivation levels also may be poor due to family conditions, inadequate motivation, inability to cope with unfamiliar mediums of instruction. These students need special attention and motivation to make their learning activity more effective. To meet the needs of slow learners following special activities are conducted.

Activities designed for Slow learners are as follows:

- College conducts a mandatory Orientation program to all the newly admitted students.
- Each department adopt suitable strategy based on the learning pace and needs of slow learners.
- Conducts bridge courses addressing diverse needs of the students for a seven to ten days at the beginning of the academic year.
- Conducts remedial classes regularly to slow learners. During these classes, teachers are expected to revise difficult topics, engage them in problem solving exercises and provide additional study material to bridge the

knowledge gap & enable them to cope with the academic course in which they are enrolled.

- Provides special Individual & Group Assignments and takes up bilingual explanations.
- SJCWA runs English Access Micro Scholarship program of the US department of state under an MOU with US consulate, provides foundation of English language skills that may lead to better jobs and educational prospects.
- Departments implement Peer Teaching-Learning strategies to make the learning process more participatory and interesting to slow learners. Faculty motivate advanced Learners to explain difficult concepts, problems or experiments to slow learners.
- Counselling of slow learners through mentor-mentee system. Informal interaction of the students with the faculty beyond regular class hours is very much in practice for the development of the students in all aspects. Mentoring provides a harmonious relationship between the students and the faculty. Small groups of 10-15 students with a faculty mentor are formed for discussions and open thinking towards the self.

Advanced Learners are those students who are bright and learn fast compared to their peers. They are more talented and can take up higher level learning and academic responsibilities. Mere classroom teaching is not sufficient for this type of student. They need more advanced academic skills and guidance for successful career planning. To meet the needs of advanced learners the following special activities are conducted.

Activities designed for Advanced Learners are as follows:

- Counselling of advanced learners through mentor-mentee system. The faculty members/mentors concerned interact with the advanced learners to identify their competencies and special interests to develop plans for their involvement and participation in various challenging programs.
- Advanced learners are encouraged to acquire advanced skills in the subject through various online platforms like SWAYAM, NPTEL, Course Era etc. and encouraged to enroll and complete MOOCs, LMS courses by giving extra credits.

- To stimulate research aptitude in advanced learners, departments provide opportunity to pursue internship/acquire hands on training on projects beyond the curriculum in reputed industries.
- Departments give guidance and training to the advanced learners for JAM, TIFR, JEST, NET, GATE, GRE, other competitive examinations and also provides preplacement training.
- SJCWA runs English Language fellow Program of the US department of state under an MOU with US consulate to improve quality of teaching. As a part of this program advanced learners benefited with multi modalities teaching methodologies.
- Departments encourages advanced learners to participate in workshops, conferences, seminars, symposiums etc.
- Competent advanced learners are encouraged to present and publish papers in national and international conferences.
- Motivate them to participate in debates, elocution, quiz etc. in state, national and international level competitions.

College encourages advanced learners by providing opportunities like:

- Students are nominated as members of BOS and IQAC.
- Meritorious students are guided to apply for Student Exchange Programs (US Consulate, Hyderabad)
- Encouraged by giving gold medals and Sr. St. Andre Best outgoing student prize to meritorious students.
- Student Achievements accomplished with Awards, Prizes & Merit Scholarships
- Students are encouraged to participate in inter collegiate competitions.

Observed Outcome:

- An overall improvement in university results was observed.
- Sizeable number of slow learners benefited by English Access Micro Scholarship program and advanced learners by English language fellow program.

- Number of students present and publish papers, earn extra credits through MOOCS, Certificate courses and NPTEL courses.
- Students have been selected for US exchange program and Sr. St. Andre Best outgoing student prize is awarded annually.
- Increase in % of students who plan their careers effectively (Placement and higher education enrolment)
