At St. Joseph's College for Women (A), we strictly adhere to the Government/University Grants Commission (UGC) guidelines on curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, as notified under Section 26(1) (g) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956.

Policy:

The Anti-Ragging Committee serves as the supervisory and advisory body responsible for maintaining a Ragging-Free environment on campus. Its objectives are as follows:

- 1. Awareness: Make students aware of the dehumanizing effects of ragging.
- 2. Vigilance: Keep vigilant to prevent and address incidents of ragging promptly.
- 3. Strict Action: Deal with reported incidents to deter future occurrences.
- 4. Discipline: Establish a culture where any act of ragging is neither tolerated nor overlooked.

Practices:

Following the Supreme Court of India and UGC directives, ragging includes but is not limited to:

- 1. Indiscipline, teasing, or rudeness.
- 2. Disruption of academic activities.
- 3. Acts causing annoyance, hardship, or fear.
- 4. Financial extortion or forceful expenditure.
- 5. Physical abuse or harm.
- 6. Verbal abuse, cyberbullying, or public insult.
- 7. Violation of human dignity.
- 8. Unlawful assembly or conspiracy to rag.

Punishments:

Students found guilty of ragging may face one or more of the following penalties:

- 1. Warning or written apology.
- 2. Suspension from classes.
- 3. Bar from exams or academic activities.
- 4. Exclusion from extracurricular events.
- 5. Hostel suspension or expulsion.
- 6. Scholarship withdrawal.
- 7. Result withholding.
- 8. Rustication or expulsion from the institution.

Powers and Functions:

The Anti-Ragging Committee is empowered to:

- 1. Uphold Supreme Court directives and prevent ragging.
- 2. Educate students on anti-ragging measures.
- 3. Conduct workshops and orientation programs.
- 4. Provide counseling and support services.
- 5. Prevent ragging on campus.
- 6. Investigate complaints and recommend punishments.
- 7. Oversee the undertaking process.

Outcomes:

- 1. New students experience a welcoming and safe environment.
- 2. Seniors offer support and guidance to juniors.
- 3. Freshers feel comfortable and secure on campus.
- 4. There is harmony and mutual respect among students.
- 5. Ragging incidents are effectively prevented and addressed.
