Dynamics of Feminist Writers: Global Perspectives 5 day Faculty development Programme -14-18 July 2018 REPORT

The Language Departments of St. Joseph's College for Women {Autonomous} Visakhapatnam, is organizing a Five Day UGC Faculty development Programme on Dynamics of Feminist Writers: Global Perspectives in collaboration with Dakshin Bharateeya Rajabhasha sansthan on 14-18 July 2018 in the College .The conference was presided over by the Principal, Dr. Sr. Shyji P.D. she mentioned in her presidential address that the present FDP has a unique identity in the Diamond Jubilee year of the College. For the first time in the history of 60 years, a FDP is organized by all the Language departments of the College – English, Hindi, Telugu and Sanskrit.

Dr. P.K.Jayalakshmi, HOD Hindi and Convener of the FDP said that Living in an inclusive world where both men and women have equanimity of gender roles, it would be good to trace feminist perspectives in writing or other spheres. The topic for the FDP has far reaching global implications in today's world, where women have progressed much and writing about women greater connotations.
