



The topic for the session was "Your 5 Steps to Graduate Studies (Master's and Ph.D. Program in the U.S.). The session started with a welcome address by Dr. T. Bhaskara Sudha, Head dept of English & IQAC Coordinator. The resource speaker for the session was Dr. Monika Setia, Regional Officer, Hyderabad, United States- India Educational Foundation (USIEF), Fulbright Commission in India, U.S. Consulate General Hyderabad. Mrs. Prameela Rani, Asst. Prof. Dept of English, introduced the resource speaker to the virtual participants, followed by the presentation of the speaker. In her talk, Dr. Monika emphasized the 5 steps for getting into master's program in U.S. Step-1 the research options available, Step-2 -Short listing the Universities relevant for one's interest, Step-3 Knowing about the Application Package, Step-4 - Knowing about the careers available, Step-5 Education USA India Virtual Services (helpline centers). Nearly 308 students of SJC registered for this session. The Q & A Session and the feedback was overwhelming. The session came to an end with vote of thanks by Sr. Latha, Asst. Prof. Dept of English.
