The National Cadet Corps (NCC) in India, established by the XXXI Act of Parliament and formally inaugurated on 15th July 1948, was initially conceptualized before independence to train youth as a secondary defense force and responsible citizens. Post-independence, it expanded to include the Girls Division in 1949, an Air Wing in 1950, and a Naval Wing in 1952, symbolizing all military services. Today, the NCC boasts over 1.3 million cadets from schools and colleges, divided into Senior and Junior Divisions/Wings, reflecting its commitment to nation-building and youth development.

- ❖ Foster leadership qualities across various domains and encourage dedicated service to the nation.
- ❖ Create a conducive environment to inspire youth towards careers in the Armed Forces.
- ❖ Instill character, camaraderie, discipline, leadership, secular values, adventurous spirit, and the ethos of selfless service among young citizens.
- ❖ Foster unity and discipline among cadets.

Practices/Activities of NCC:

- ❖ St. Joseph's College for Women (A), Visakhapatnam, operates under the 2(A) Girls Battalion, offering a voluntary NCC program with an allotted strength of 160 cadets.
- ❖ NCC parades are conducted twice weekly, comprising both single and double parades to fulfill annual requirements.
- ❖ Parades include drill training and theoretical sessions on specialized and general subjects.
- ❖ Various camps such as Annual Training Camp (ATC), Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC), Thal Sainik Camp (TSC), PRE Republic-Day Camp (Pre RDC), RDC, Local Republic Day Camp (LRDC), Local Independence Day Camp (LIDC), Annual Leadership Camp (ALC), National Integration Camp (NIC), Army Attachment Camp, etc., are organized.
- ❖ Institutional training focuses on discipline, duty, punctuality, respect, ethics, and self-confidence.
- ❖ Camp training fosters camaraderie, teamwork, leadership, self-reliance, and dignity of labor.
- ❖ Certificate examinations 'B' & 'C' are conducted biennially for eligible cadets.

- ❖ 'B' & 'C' Certificate holders enjoy preferential treatment in Central and State Government organizations, recognizing their NCC achievements.
