#### Rationale of the Faculty Development Program

Hence, the title of the program 'Trends and Trend-setting in the Mid-21<sup>st</sup> Century". There is certainly a need for change and therefore innovation finds pride of place in the very first session of this program.

In a world ridden by manifold distractions, especially in online learning, students are increasingly recorded low attention and concentration levelsboth of which are essential for knowledge retention and better learning outcomes. In such a scenario, it is of utmost urgency and necessity for teachers to bring into their classrooms methods that hold and capture the attention of the students. This is where digital teaching and learning has its relevance. As the EdTech sector flourishes, so will the education system which will see students benefit from developing technologies.

On Day - 6 the moderator was Dr. Tonia Grace, Assistant Professor Dept of English, SJCW introduced the resource speaker to the virtual participants.


