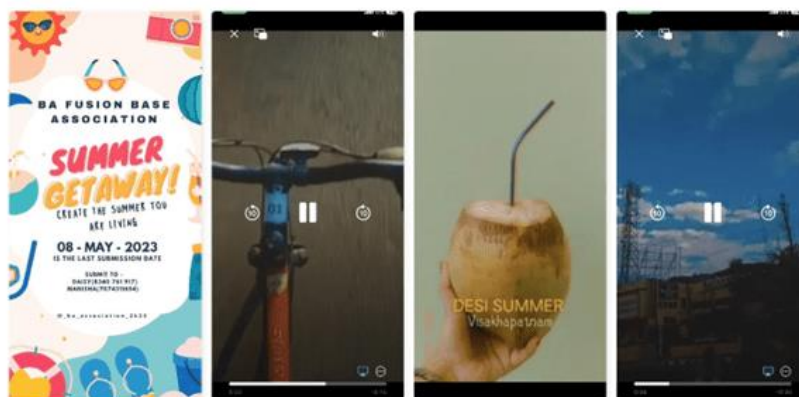

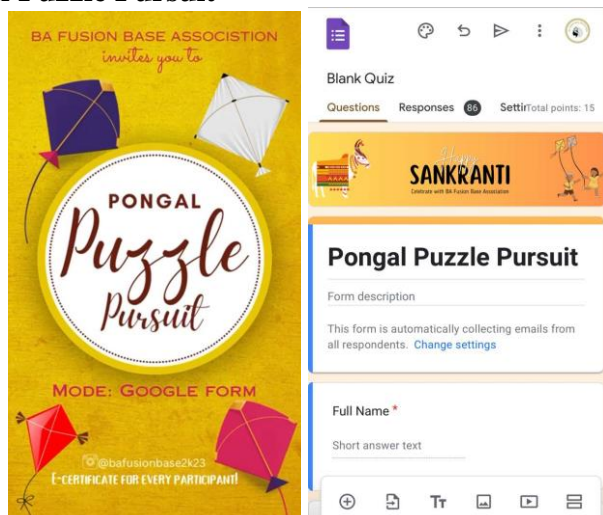

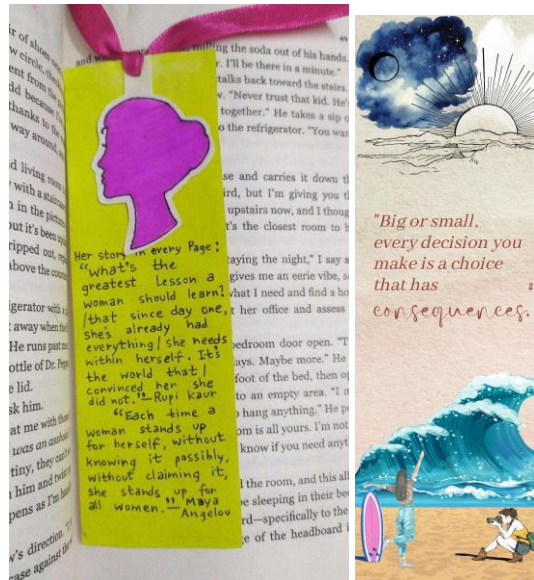

Number of participants: 10

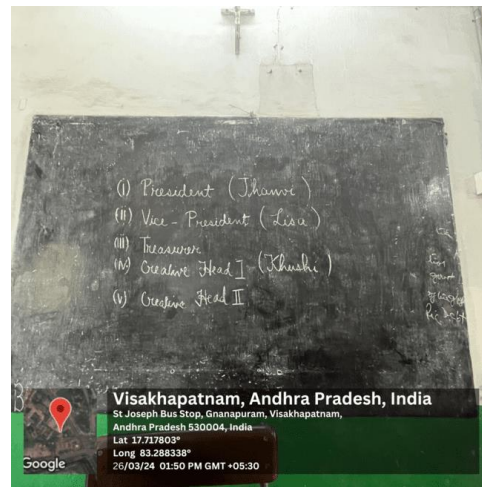
