REPORT ON THE FIVE-DAY FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

"Team Building & Leadership"

The inaugural session of the programme was held on 4th March 2023 at 10 am.

The resource person/Facilitator was Mr. Imtiaz Arshad, CEO & Secretary, Skill Development Institute, Visakhapatnam.

The programme started by the address of the Principal, Dr.Sr.Shyji followed by the introduction of the resource person, address of Mr. Imtiaz Arshad, CEO & Secretary, SDI.

Leadership and team building training courses are specifically designed to improve leadership skills with the purpose of enabling agents to lead successful, high performing teams. Team building workshops are packed full of useful teamwork training exercises, tips and techniques that are essential in showing how to lead effectively. leadership and team building workshop's help to create highly productive teams and mould yourself into a great leader.

The facilitator asked the participants to discuss their short-term, long-term goals and he emphasized on that planning is essential to achieving both short-and long-term goals and future goals.

Teams or groups were created to carry out specific tasks, games where the teams were asked to discuss the competencies and were asked to reflect on the team work, leadership, strengths and weaknesses of the team. Members to explore and understand the behaviour of the team members.

The five-day faculty Development programme held on 4th,5th,6th,7th and 11th March,2024 was enriching with a number of activities and games focussing on team building and leadership strategies.

The facilitator conducted the following activities/games during the FDP.

6	Paper Tearing	Adaptability, Leadership	Strategic thinking	Communication	Each player has to tear the paper as it is instructed to them and it should resemble the final shape of the paper of instructor
7	Tarp Hole	Team building	prioritisation	Communication	Each team consists of 8-10 members should make the 5 different coloured balls into the same coloured holes as the balls, whoever scores more balls are the winners. Resource utilisation & strategizing by leader and team

	8	Human Conveyor Belt	Coordination, Leadership	Team building	Conflict handling	Each team have to travel from point A to point B in a belt like cloth given by the instructor and whichever team reaches first is the winner. Resource utilisation & strategizing by leader and team
•	9	Passing the Baton	Coordination, Leadership	Team building	Strategic thinking	In each team players (each team has leader) have to pass their batons to the other person and catch the others' batons as well without letting any of those falling to the ground which will give them positive score and the highest scoring team wins
	10	Baba baby ball	Agility	Conflict handling	Adaptability	Each team consists of 2 babas on either side and a baby in the center and the one left out guy (dinner) would say baba/baby/ball and the players have to move accordingly meanwhile dinner person will occupy any empty place among the teams and another left out person will do the same again, it's just an energizer
	11	Win as Much as You Can	Team building, Collaboration	Strategic thinking, Leadership	Conflict handling	Each team with a leader is given X & Y to choose and scores will be according to the letters and rules given. Teams usually try to kill other teams' score in order to win but actually they can win only when they all communicate and stand on one word
	12	Board Room	Conflict handling	Adaptability	Empathy	all the 5 players will be bound with a tag on them which tells the audience how to react to their speech and we can't expect everyone will react the same way to all of us we should accept the reality and adapt it

13	Petrol Pump	Conflict handling	Negotiation	Adaptability	The petrol pump owner wants to go home and close the pump and at the last moment you'd come to the spot and convince him to give petrol and the only way to convince to him is to know his problem not telling our problems alone
14	Balloon kebab	Excellence	strategic thinking	Adaptability	Each player would be given a sharp stick and a balloon and they have to blow the balloon and pierce the stick through the balloon without blowing it up
15	Hunter rabbit wall	situational leadership	strategic thinking	Team work, Coordination	it is all about strategy and observation and communication to grow in our own when we are uncertain of the other team or company. Each team has a leader who strategizes.
16	Cup Tower	situational leadership	strategic thinking, Excellence	Team work	Each team (with a leader) will be given a cup pack to build the tallest tower and team with the tallest tower wins but they will be blindfolded while building the tower
17	Keep the Balloons in the Air	Conflict handling, Leadership	Adaptability, multi-tasking	Agility	Each player should float the balloons in the air without them touching the ground until the timer stops, highest scoring team wins

While team building depends on the cooperation of all group members, the role of a leader is especially important. A good leader promotes teamwork and models ideal behaviour for the team. This individual assesses the team's abilities and draws out the group's true potential by consciously building relationships and sharpening skills. The leader creates environments in which teams can thrive.

After the five-day programme, the valedictory session was conducted on 11th March 2024 in the seminar hall, Principal Dr.Sr. Shyji, Vice principal, Sr. Hema thanked Mr. Imtiaz sir for organising this FDP programme and Dr.Harini, proposed the formal vote of thanks.





