Anti-Ragging Committee

The Anti-Ragging Committee of St. Joseph's College for Women serves as the leading force in creating and maintaining a ragging-free environment on campus. This committee is dedicated to achieving this key objective through the following actions:

Objectives:

- To prevent, prohibit, and redress all forms of nagging in the institution
- To educate students on the meaning and consequences of nagging
- To create a nagging-free environment on campus

Functions:

- Investigate complaints of ragging: The committee must have a clear and well-defined procedure for receiving, investigating, and addressing complaints of nagging. This should include ensuring confidentiality for complainants and witnesses.
- Take appropriate action against those found guilty of ragging: This could include rustication, suspension, expulsion, or even legal action, depending on the severity of the offense.
- Monitor the effectiveness of anti-ragging measures: The committee should regularly review its own performance and assess the effectiveness of the institution's anti-nagging policies and procedures.
- Conduct awareness programs and workshops: The committee should organize regular awareness programs and workshops to educate students about nagging and its consequences.
- Liaise with other relevant authorities: The committee should maintain communication and cooperation with other relevant authorities, such as the police and anti-nagging helplines, to ensure a coordinated response to nagging incident

Restricting and Preventing Ragging: Potential Consequences

To uphold a nagging-free environment, the following consequences may be imposed on individuals or groups found guilty of nagging, within or beyond campus grounds:

1. Formal Warnings and Apologies:

- Issuing a formal written warning to the individuals involved.
- Requiring the individuals to submit a written apology to the victim(s).

2. Academic Restrictions:

- Suspension from attending classes and academic activities for a specified period.
- Disqualification from taking specific tests or examinations.

- 4. Residential Implications:
 - Suspension or expulsion from the college hostel.
- 5. Financial Consequences:
 - Withdrawal of scholarship or other financial benefits.
- 6. Result Disbursement Delay:
 - Withholding of academic results for a specific period.
- 7. Institutional Restrictions:
 - Rustication, meaning temporary suspension from the institution for a period ranging from one to four semesters.
 - Suspension from the college for a determined timeframe.
 - Admission cancellation for proven involvement in nagging activities.
- 8. Most Serious Consequences:
 - Expulsion from the institution, accompanied by a ban on seeking admission to any other educational institution for a specific period.
