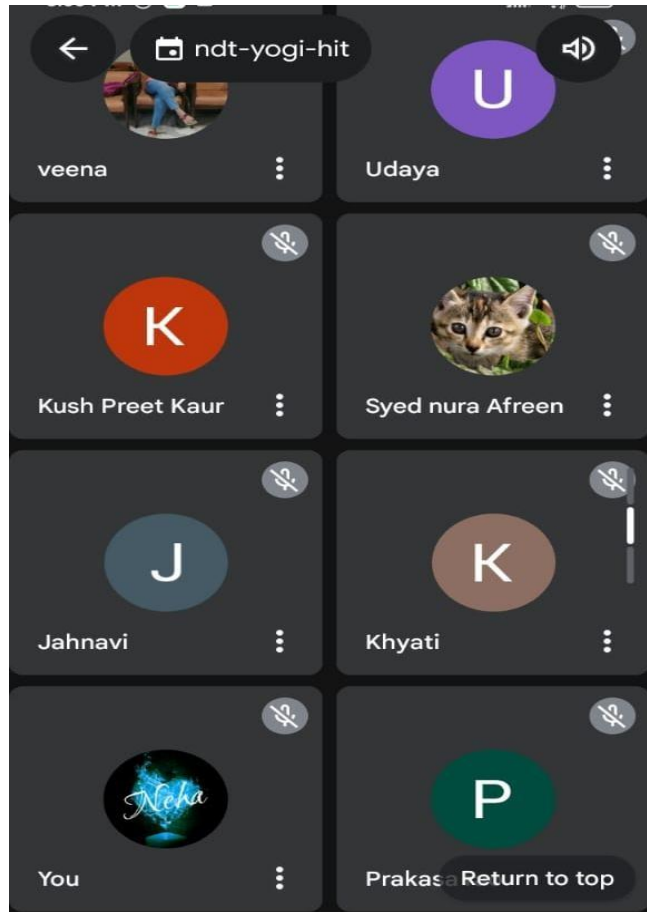
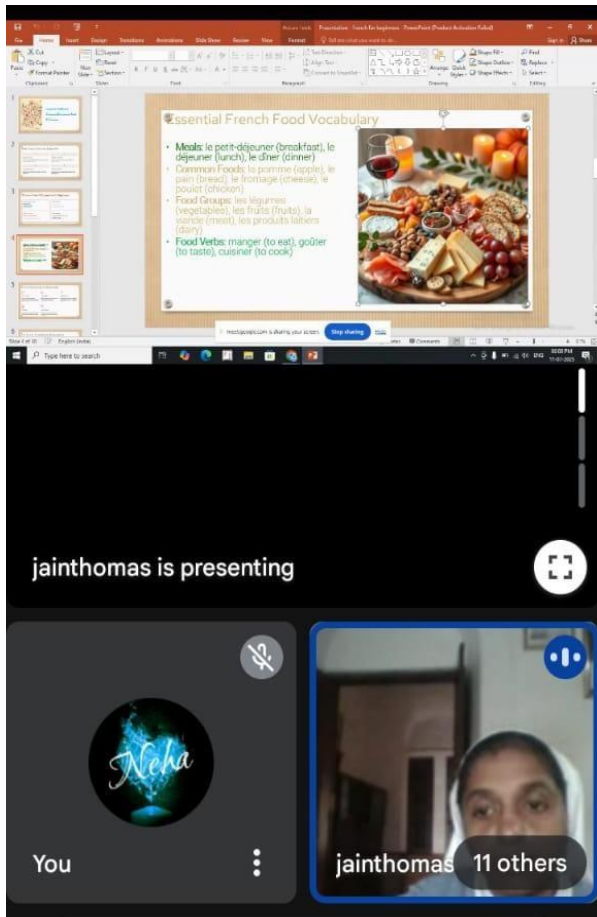

Sreoshi Sarkar (Junior BiPC)

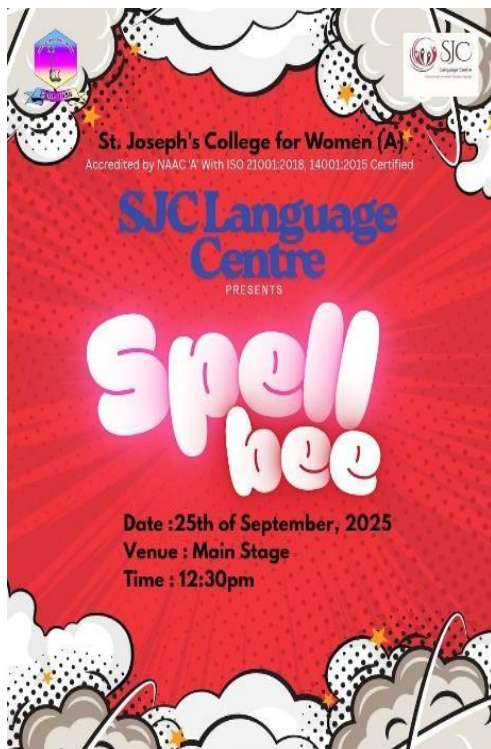

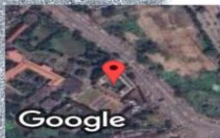
