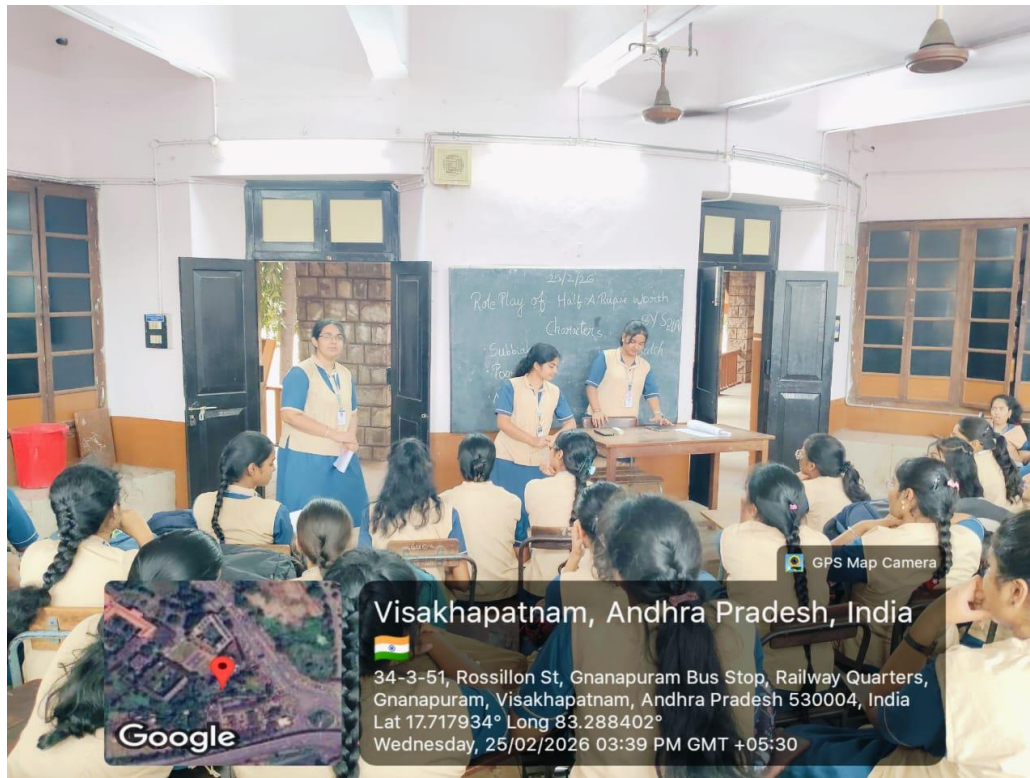
Activity 7-Theatre day

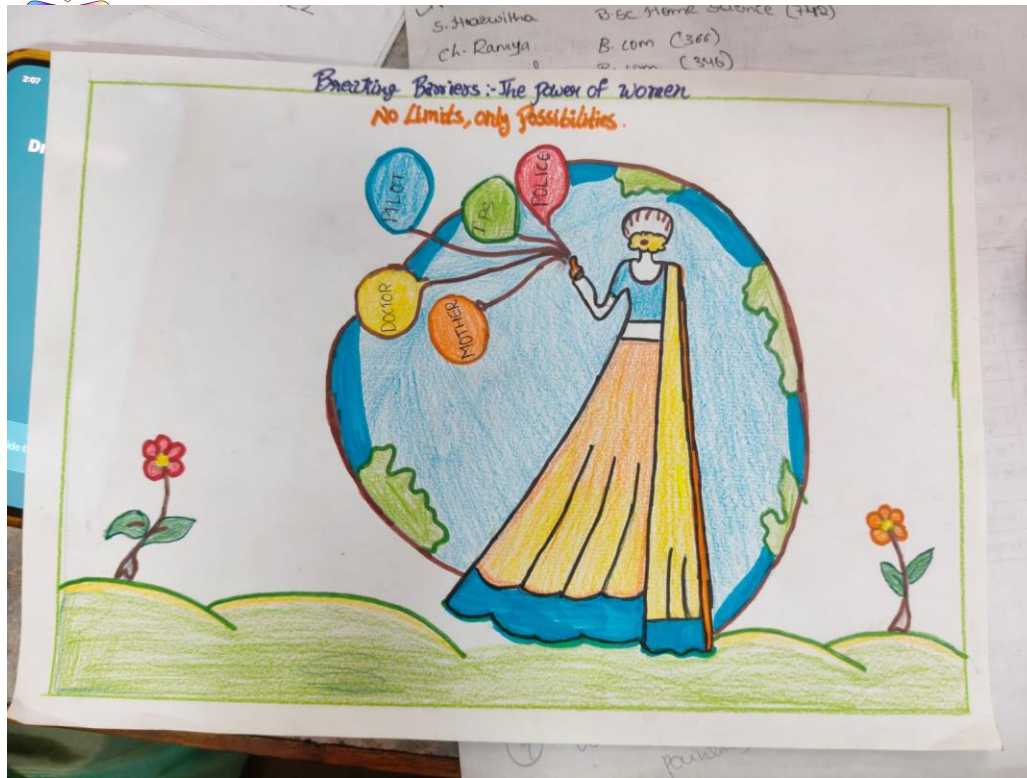
