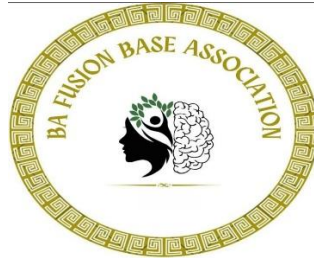

**Date:** 24-07-2024

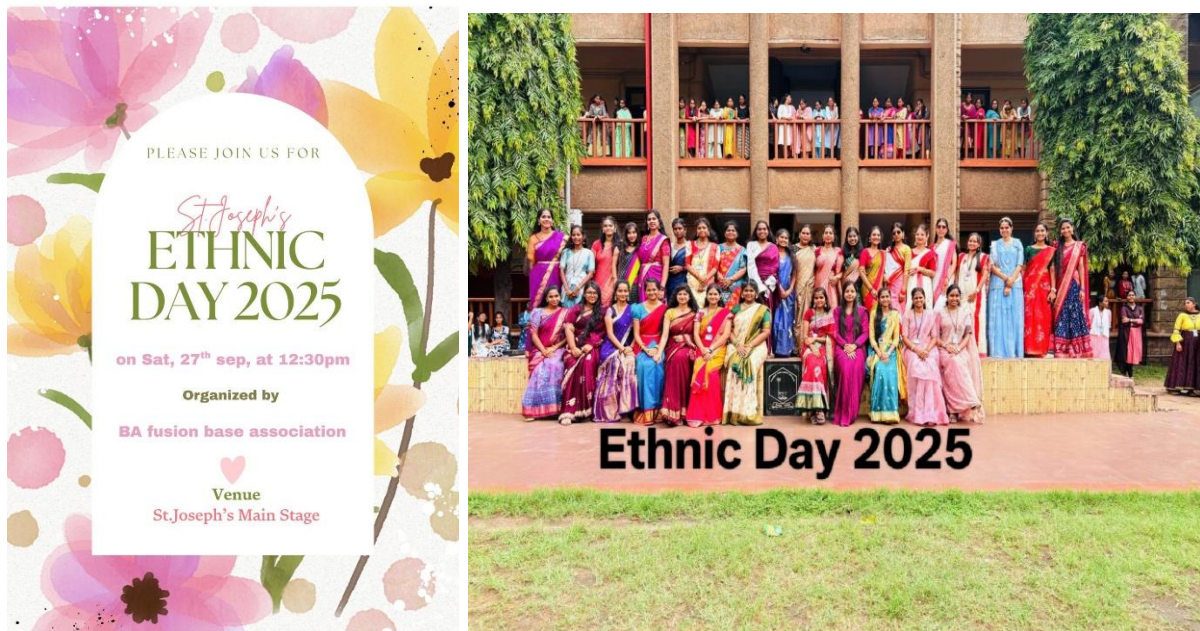
**Venue:** G Room

Number of participants: 32

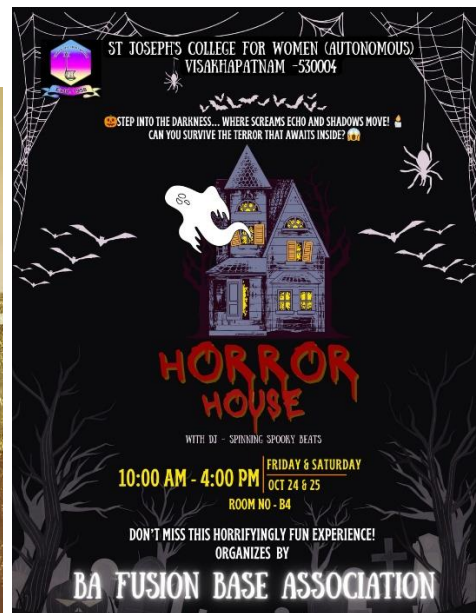

Venue: College Campus

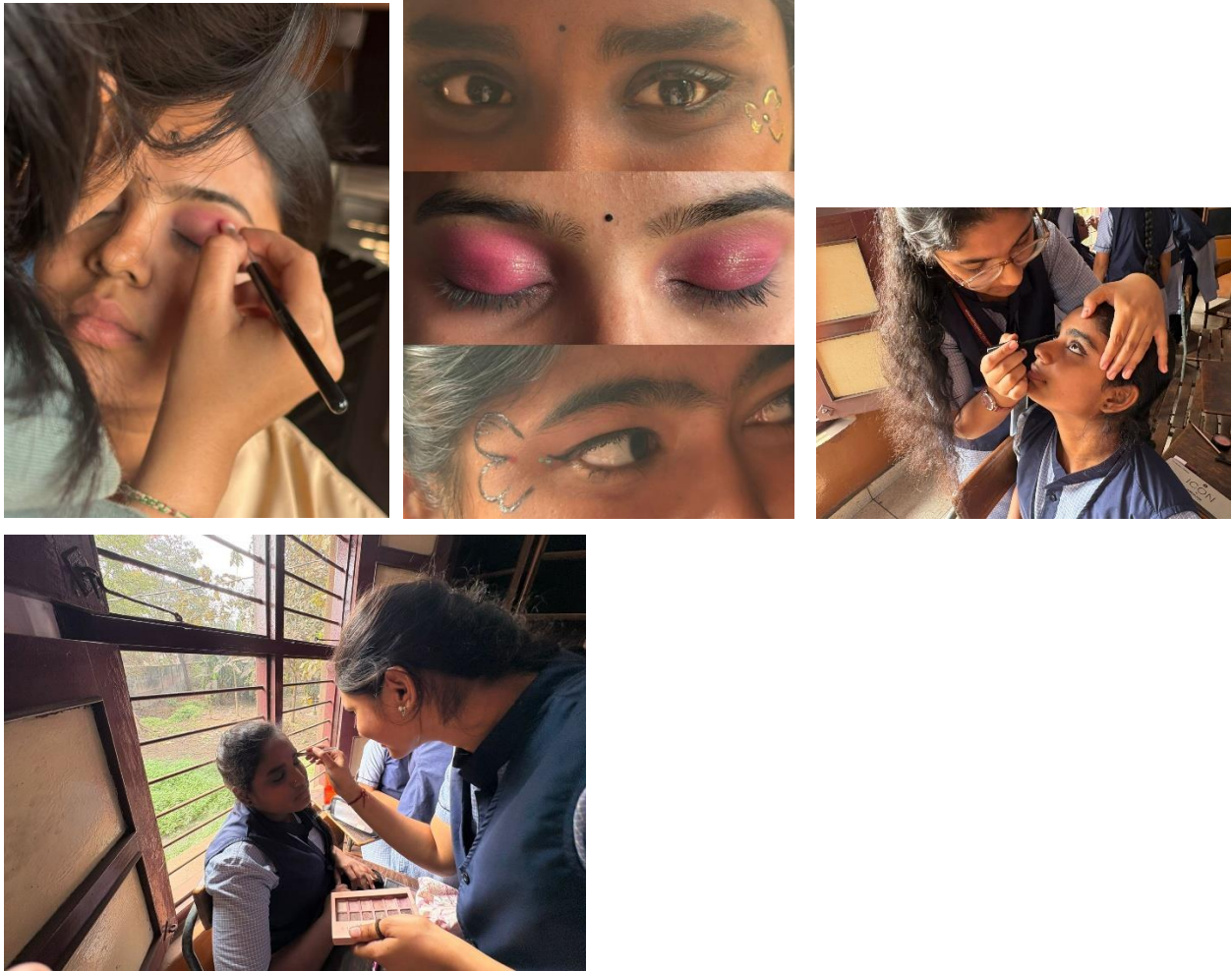
