Report on Orientation Programme for Fresh Faculty – 2026–2027

St. Joseph's College for Women (Autonomous), Visakhapatnam, organized an Orientation Programme for Fresh Faculty for the Academic Year 2026–27 on 13 July 2026 in the Seminar Hall. The programme was conducted from 9:15 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. to familiarize newly appointed faculty members with the academic structure, functioning of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), autonomous system, and evaluation methodology of the institution.

The orientation programme comprised three informative sessions, each focusing on an important aspect of the academic and administrative functioning of the college.

The first session, held from 9:15 a.m. to 10:15 a.m., was on “Course Structure” and was conducted by Dr. P. Aruna Devi, Academic Coordinator. The session provided the fresh faculty with an overview of the academic framework and course structure followed by the institution. The participants were oriented on the organization of academic programmes, curriculum structure, and the responsibilities of faculty members in effectively implementing the curriculum. The session helped the newly appointed faculty understand the academic processes and expectations of the institution.

The second session, from 10:15 a.m. to 11:15 a.m., focused on “IQAC – Its Functions” and was conducted by Dr. Bhaskara Sudha, IQAC Coordinator. The session introduced the participants to the role and significance of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in maintaining and enhancing quality standards in the institution. The faculty members were familiarized with the various quality initiatives, academic documentation, institutional practices, and the role of individual faculty members in contributing to continuous quality improvement. The session emphasized the importance of active faculty participation in strengthening the quality culture of the institution.

The third session, held from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., was on “Autonomy – Evaluation Methodology” and was conducted by the Examination Department. The session provided an understanding of the autonomous status of the institution and the evaluation procedures followed by the college. The fresh faculty were oriented on the examination and assessment system and the responsibilities associated with evaluation under the autonomous framework. The session enabled the participants to gain clarity regarding the procedures and practices to be followed in the assessment of students.

As per the attendance sheet included in the document, 13 faculty members were listed for the programme, of whom 10 attended, and 3 were marked absent. The participants represented various departments, including Chemistry, Commerce and Management, Computer Science, English, Psychology, Agriculture and Rural Development, and Forensic Science.

The Orientation Programme was informative and beneficial to the newly appointed faculty members, as it provided them with a comprehensive introduction to the institution's academic structure, quality assurance mechanisms, autonomy, and evaluation system. The programme facilitated a better understanding of their academic and institutional responsibilities and prepared them to contribute effectively towards achieving the quality and excellence envisioned by the institution.

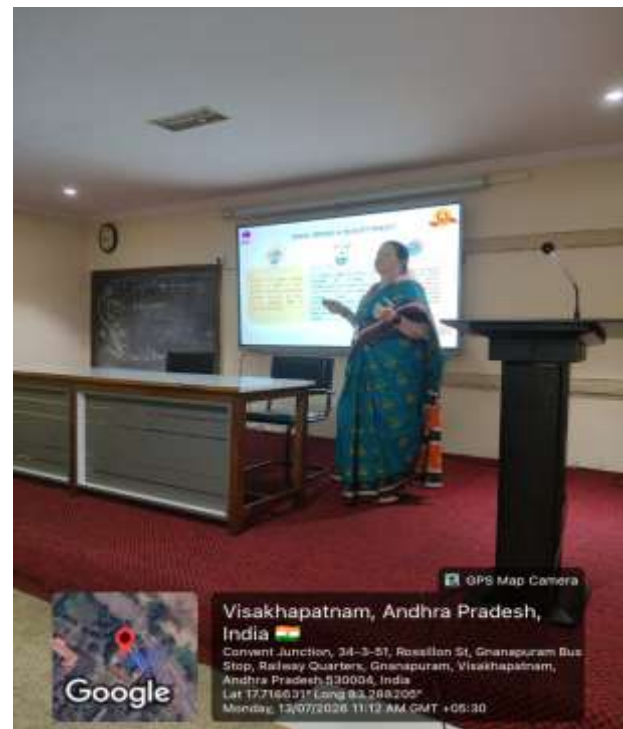

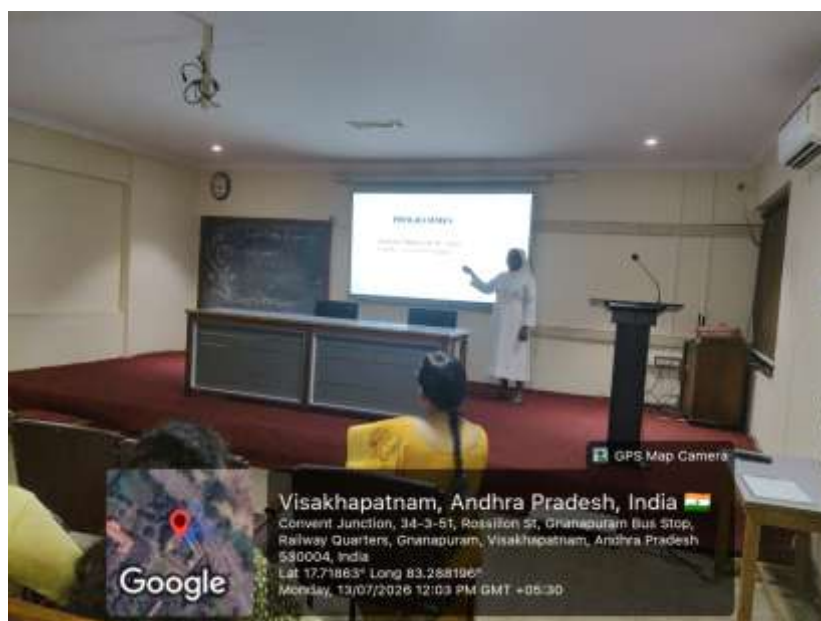
